





# BACKGROUND





### **PROCESS**

#### Phase I - Vision

By April 2017, Board adopts desired vision as an early outcome of the small area plan process.

#### Phase II – Design

By October 2017, Board receives recommendations to increase opportunities for by-right development that meets urban form established in Comprehensive Plan through proactive rezoning and improves balance between commercial, industrial and residential tax base.

#### Phase III - Implement

By May 2018, present draft ordinance to implement Rio/29 vision and encourage by-right implementation of desired urban land use form.

#### **Key Takeaways from Phase I**


- The future vision for Rio/29 is <u>Transformational</u> – not a continuation of current trends.
- 2. The key concept for this transformational vision vision is the "15 minute walkable community"
- This concept organizes future development/redevelopment into walkable centers
- 4. This phase defined 3 potential centers with principle center on Rio/29

  - ex: the County's main center or "uptown", the main center for Route 29, one of many centers along Route 29?

## Transportation and interconnectivity

- Where and how should we provide for pedestrians and bicyclists to get across Route 29?
- How can we better connect the four "quadrants" around the Rio/29 intersection?
- How can we encourage people to walk/bike/use transit when traveling to and within this area?
