
Culpeper District Geography

Charlottesville Residency



Route 29 Solutions: Results

Motor vehicle crashes *

- 43% reduction in crashes
- 54% reduction injury crashes

Corridor travel times **

- 15% reduction SB peak time
- 31% reduction NB peak time


Annual cost savings based on travel time reduction: \$4.5 M

- * 1 yr. after completion of Rio GSI compared with average crashes 4 yrs prior
- ** Hydraulic Road to Airport Road using Bluetooth data collected before projects & after completion of Hillsdale Dr. Extended

U.S. 29-Hydraulic Road **Recommended Projects**

Improve safety and mobility at the US 29-Hydraulic Rd intersection and nearby intersections and interchanges

- Address congestion by limiting access to US 29 with grade-separated interchanges and improving traffic throughput with roundabouts
- Address safety by constructing bicycle/pedestrian improvements along US 29 and limiting access to US 29 with grade-separated interchanges

Under Construction

 Dickerson Road bridge over North Fork Rivanna River Replace truss with 3-ton weight limit; at completion bridge will accommodate all legal loads

Upcoming Construction

Belmont Bridge replacement: City of Charlottesville
 \$25.5 million project, construction to begin 2020

Design (estimate ~ \$28.4 M)

 Districtwide: 13 bridge replacement/rehab projects (\$26.6 mil)
 & 5 bridge replacement/rehab projects with early "State of Good Repair" PE funds only
