





The Good: More Job Creation Nationally




Virginia by the numbers

Budget Highlights 2017


- * 3% Raises to law enforcement and state employees
- * \$32 million for mental health
- * Addressed shortfall with tax amnesty, \$567 million rainy day fund, and cuts



Budget 2017: Accomplishments

Higher Education

- * Reduced some cuts to Universities
- Funding still languishes as tuition rises



Budget 2017: Accomplishments

K-12 education

- 2% Raise for teachers (still lags behind national average)
- •Increased spending to \$5448 per pupil, still down 11% from 2009

2017 Session Successes

Heavy lifting: 1,847 bills and resolutions introduced, 1243 passed

- * Combating Opioids more Virginians die now from overdose than from car accidents
 - * HB 2165: Mandates that opioid prescriptions be electronically transmitted to pharmacies
 - * SB848: Allows community organizations to possess and dispense naloxone.
 - * HB 2317: Legalizes clean syringe programs, to combat HIV and Hepatitis C
 - * HB 1786: Assists children exposed to opiods in Utero

2017 Successes

- * Expansion of the Address Confidentiality program to protect victims of crime
- * Airbnb Registration
- * New bills to encourage solar power
- * Judicial Discretion when suspending driver's licenses
- * HB 2267: Can buy 12 month supply of hormonal contraceptives
- * HB 2289: Permits life insurance be ordered in divorce
- * HB 1456: Redefines visitation as "parenting time"

2017 Successes

Mental Health Legislation

- * \$23.9 million to help people with mental illness
- * HB 2258: Department of Behavioral Health and Development Services to report on its activities related to suicide prevention

2017 Failures

No Medicaid Expansion




Impact of ACA Repeal on VA

- •339,000 Virginians lose coverage, including 22,000 children


Impact of ACA Repeal




- No student debt relief

- No gun safety bills passed






Failure of Redistricting Reform








Why States Matter - Chambers held by Party


