

Beginning with the June 8, 2022 Meeting

Due to the advent of COVID restrictions, effective June 2020 the Senior Statesmen of Virginia (SSV) curtailed in-person programs and made the programs available via the Zoom computer Internet platform. The board understands that just as it was challenging to forego in-person meetings when COVID turned our world upside down, so will it require adjustment as we return to in-person meetings. We will return to in-person meeting for June 8th....and will welcome your feedback about in-person meetings, Zoom meetings and hybrid meetings.

We have reviewed options for meeting locations that allow both Board meetings and program meetings at the same location, on the same day. As we looked for space that would not incur costs, we agreed to move our meetings at **Westminster-Canterbury of the Blue Ridge.**



The June 8th meeting will begin at 1:30 pm at WCBR in their 150-seat Rotunda Room. For your health safety and peace of mind, we will require proof of vaccination and wearing of face coverings. In addition, the room will allow for socially distanced seating.

Directions to Westminster-Canterbury of the Blue Ridge—Rotunda Room





Turn onto Pantops Mountain Road from Route 250 (Richmond Road). Tell the attendant at the gatehouse you are attending the Senior Statesmen program.





After passing through the gatehouse checkpoint, turn left onto Pantops Mountain Road (see sign above) then turn right onto Bishops Ridge Drive. See sign for "Catered Living" parking, turn left into the lot.

Parking is in the "Catered Living" parking lot in front of the main building.

Enter main building, go right following signs to the Rotunda Room. SSV registration is inside Rotunda Room, where proof of vaccination and face covering will be required.



In case you missed the May 11 meeting:

General Assembly Update 2022

Three of our local General Assembly members were able to participate in our annual May General Assembly Update meeting: Senator Creigh Deeds, Delegate Matt Fariss and Delegate Sally Hudson. The current status of Virginia government with a Republican governor and Republican majority in the house and a Democratic majority in the Senate has led to gridlock in approving the budget which is still not finalized. If it is not approved by July 1, 2022, it is possible that Virginia government will shut down. All the participants expressed hope that agreement will be reached.

Even with the current budget surplus the parties agree that what must also be taken into account is that the cost of supplies, labor, etc., have significantly increased so the state is not as flush with cash as it seems. Many topics were addressed during the presentation, but mental health was a priority of all three speakers. Funding for better support services and housing for persons with mentally illness were primary needs. The differences between running a business or government have caused some concerns with the Democrats who believe that the more transparency the better as opposed to the Republican position that some work should not be public information in that it may stifle participation in government. Other questions from the audience concerned the Dillon Rule (local government needs state approval to raise

and levy taxes), constitutionality of executive orders, Tip Line, and Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).
